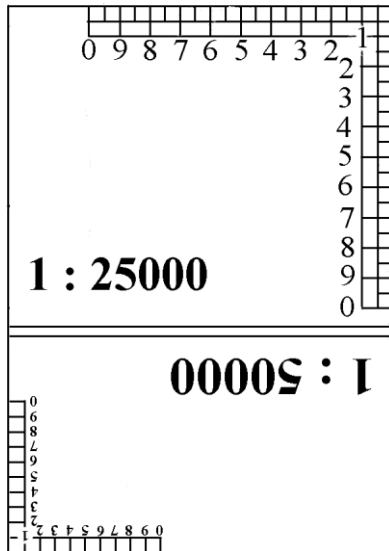

## MAP REFERENCING AND USING A ROMER.

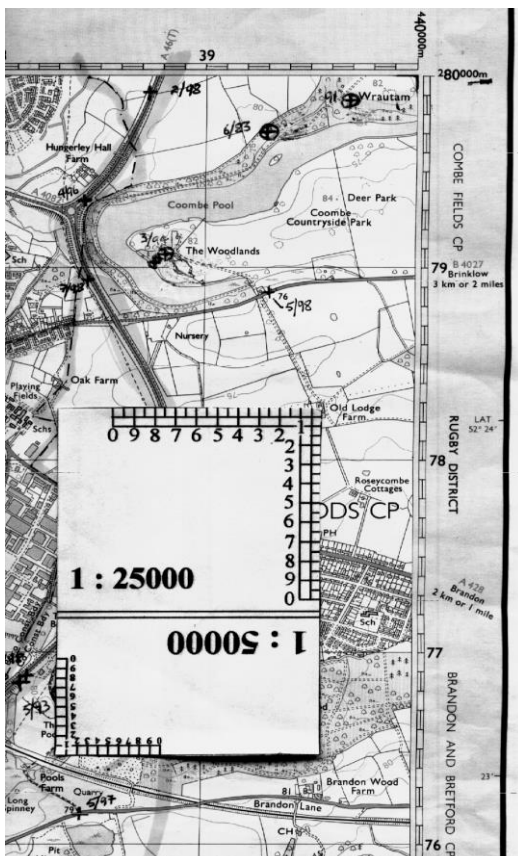


The figure to the left is reasonably to scale.

If it is cut out, stuck to a piece of thin card and then carefully trimmed, it can be useful.

It can be made more durable by covering both sides with clear self-adhesive film of the type used for covering books.

### EXAMPLE OF HOW TO USE A ROMER



To determine the grid reference for Old Lodge Farm, place the top right-hand corner of the Romer using the appropriate scale (1 : 25000) at the centre of the farm on your map.

The first two digits of the Easting are the numbers of the nearest vertical grid-line on the map to the left, in this case 39.

The second two digits are read off the scale along the upper edge of the Romer, reading from right to left, where that same vertical line passes through the scale. In this case 57.

**The Easting is therefore 3957.**

The Northing is determined in like manner using the nearest horizontal grid-line on the map below the farm, in this case 78. This passes through the right-hand scale on the Roamer at 28.

**The Northing is therefore 7828.**

**So the full 8-digit reference for Old Lodge Farm is SP3957 7828.**
